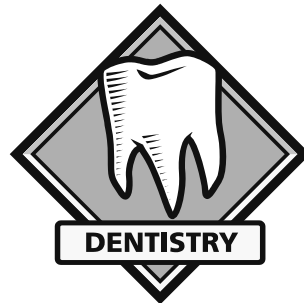
Our Lady of Peace Catholic Cemetery

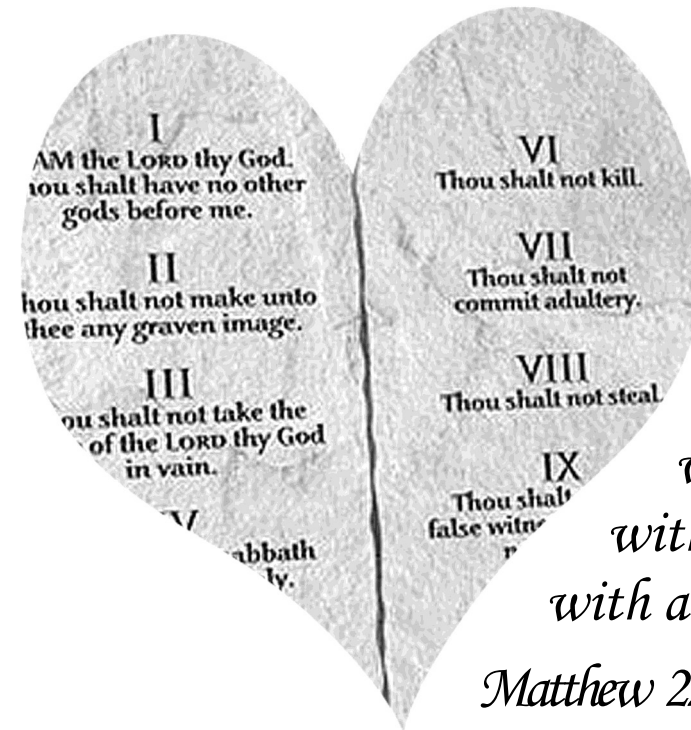

that contain the entire mass setting and will add them to the pew cards.

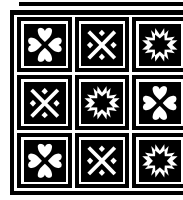
