(The reflections from Carolyn Notestein, one of our founders, continue.)

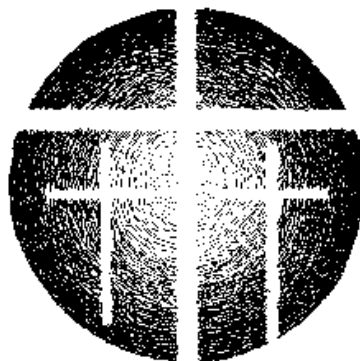
