This version of Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem is by Giotto di Bondone. It is the image of a fresco, created between 1304 and 1306, at the Arena Chapel (Cappella Scrovegni) in Padua, Italy. The decoration of this chapel is considered Giotto's masterwork. The fresco cycle on the chapel walls depicts scenes from the life of the Blessed Virgin as well as scenes from the life of Christ.

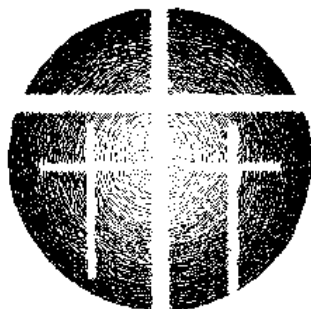

The prison ministry (which began at the time Fr. Dick Kirch), grew to include bringing the ecumenical Kairos program to those incarcerated. There were many changes, surprises (and conversions) from those who received ministry from Kairos and those who came from the outside. Many of the people in the parish worked hard to set up summer programs for the children, often working together with other church-

es in Appomattox. If I remember correctly, the first one was an ecumenical effort in combination with St. Anne's Episcopal Church.
