
Rachel's Vineyard Retreat for Healing After Abortion

Maintaining Inner Peace — A Soup and Study facilitated by:

Sr. Carrie Ann McKeown, Franciscan Sister, TOR, of Penance of the Sorrowful Mother

On July 21, after the 5:00pm Mass, Sr. Carrie Ann McKeown will be leading a "Soup and Study" at Resurrection Catholic Church. Sr. Carrie Ann (sister of Melissa Murtagh) will be diving into this difficult topic of trying to find and maintain the peace that the Lord has promised us.
