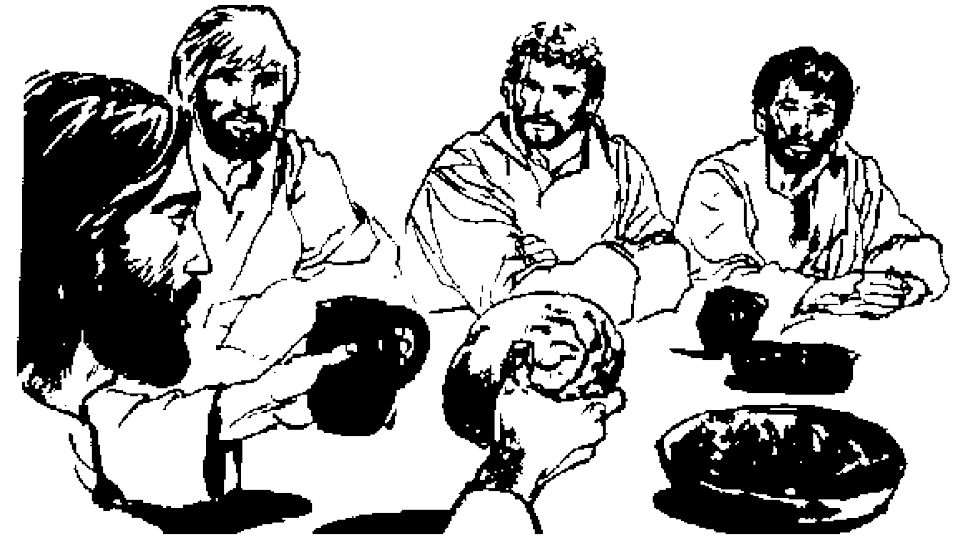
25th Annual Catholic Retreat-O-Ree

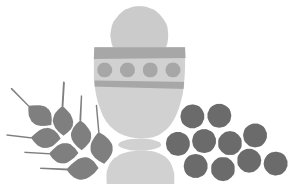

Next LPA 18 Meeting

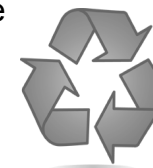
