Liturgy Planning

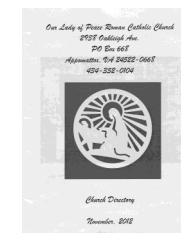
The next meeting of the Liturgy Planning Committee is scheduled on Tuesday, November 20th right after 7 p.m. Mass.
