Televised Sunday Mass

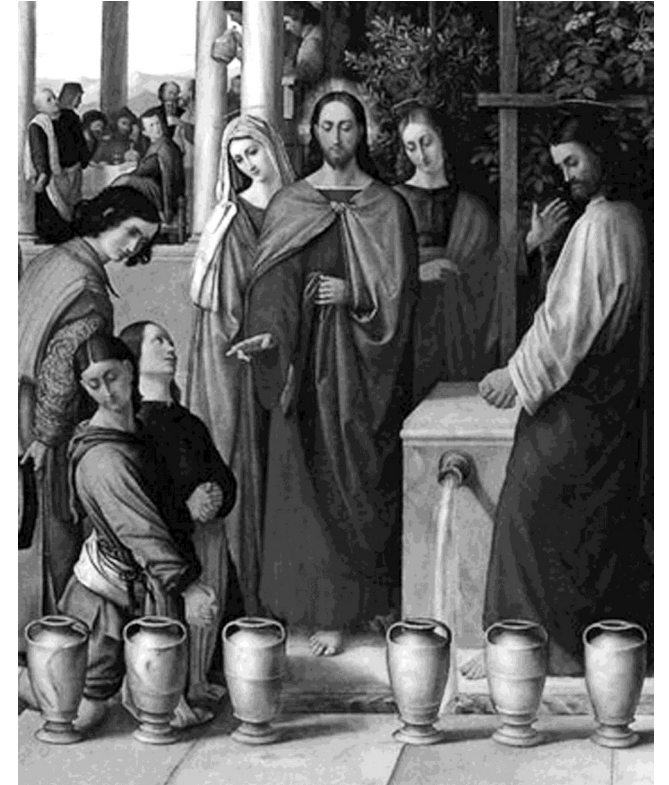

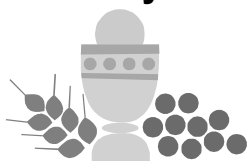
