Televised Sunday Mass

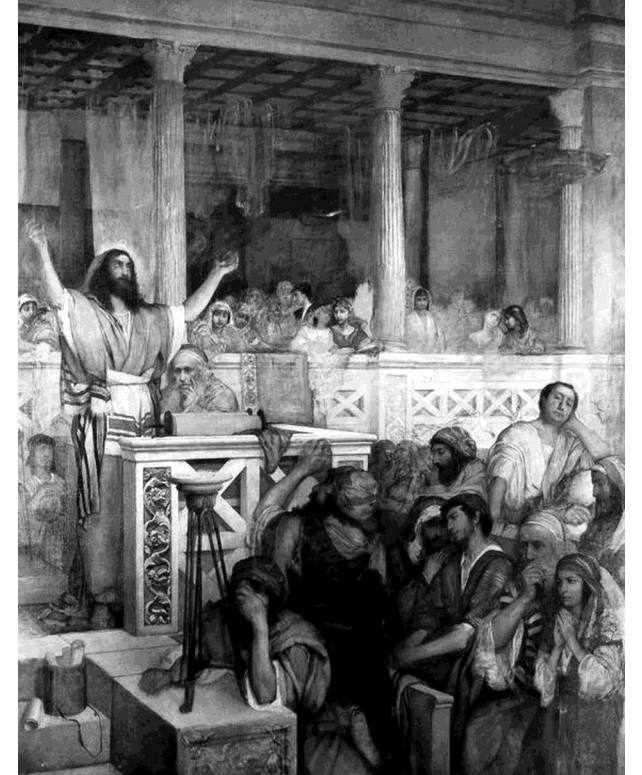

Fr. Jim will be here for the prayer as he will also have to be at the St. Victoria celebration earlier.

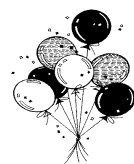

This painting of Jesus preaching in the synagogue at Capernaum is the work of the Polish-Jewish artist Maurycy Gottlieb (1856-1879). He depicts Our Lord with earlocks, and wearing the traditional prayer shawl. In Gottlieb's painting Jesus is preaching to a mixed crowd - including one woman standing alongside the men and not in the section reserved for female members of the congregation. The painting can be found in the National Museum in Warsaw.
