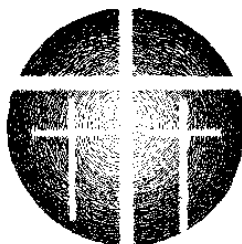

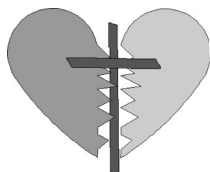

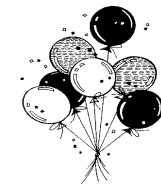

**On the Cover**

On today's cover is the watercolor *The Vine Dresser and the Fig Tree* by the French artist James Tissot. Tissot had much success as a painter in Paris and London in the 1870s and 1880s. While visiting the Church of St. Sulpice however, he experienced a vision, deserted his former themes, and embarked on a project to illustrate the New Testament. He made trips to the Middle East to record the landscape, architecture, costumes, and customs of the Holy Land and its people. Unlike earlier artists, who had often depicted biblical figures in the settings and costumes of their own times, Tissot painted his many figures in costumes he believed to be historically authentic, carrying out his series with considerable archaeological correctness. This painting, although not currently on display, is in the Collection of the Brooklyn Museum.
