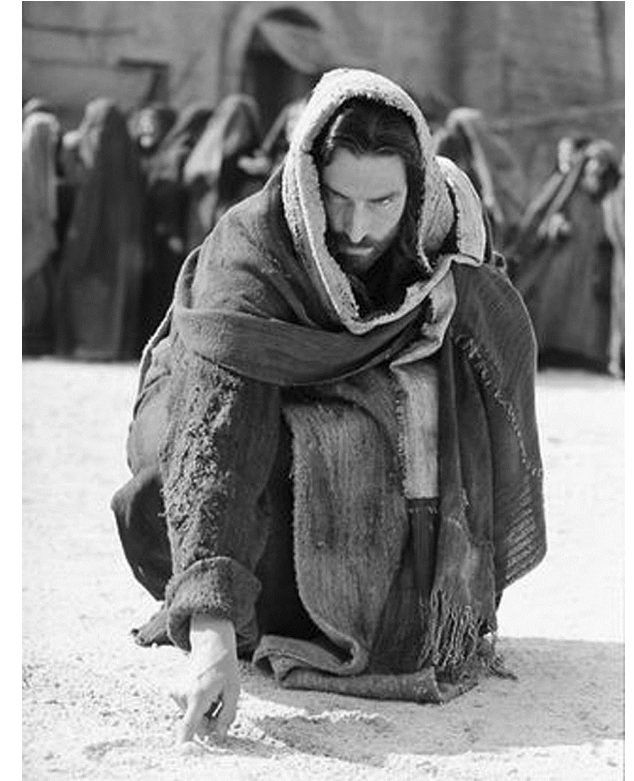

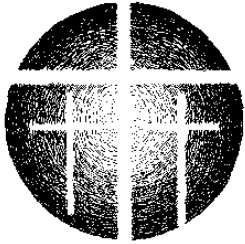

meet after 8:30am Mass

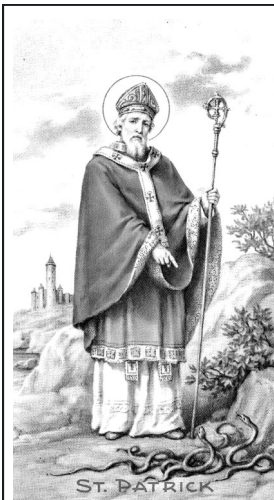
