On Tuesday April 9th after the 7 p.m. mass a tentative gardening meeting will be held to discuss the upkeep of our flower beds.

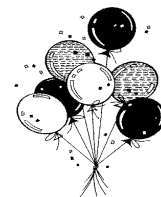
**Dinner and Entertainment**
