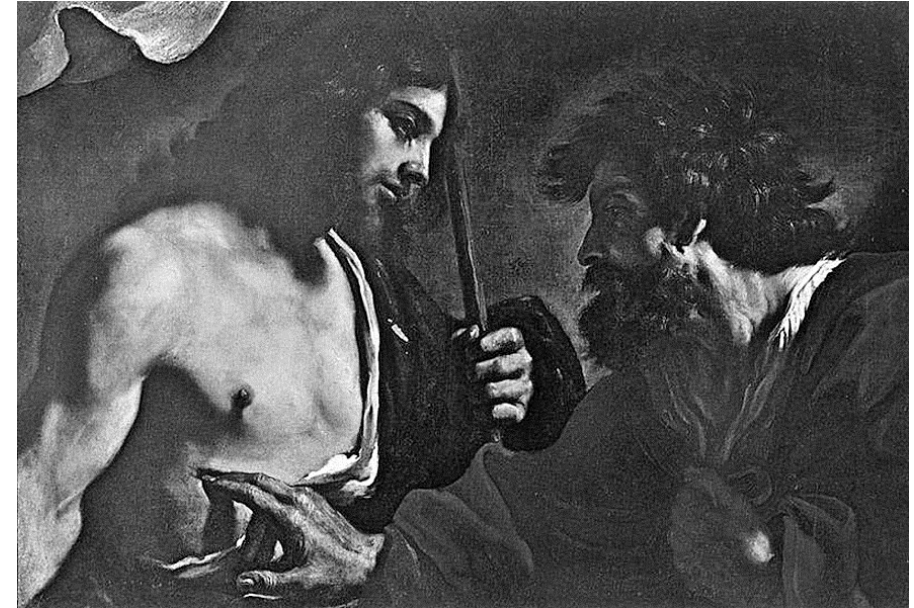

On May 19, which is Pente-

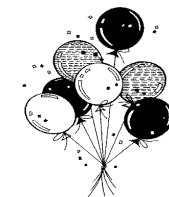
