On the Cover

On the cover is the painting *What-Our-Saviour-Saw-from-
the-Cross-(or-Christ-Consoling-the-Wanderers)* by the
French artist James Tissot. Tissot, a popular artist in Eu-
rope in the 1870 and 80s, spent the later part of his life illus-
trating the Bible. He made trips to the Middle East to record
the landscape, architecture, costumes, and customs of the
Holy Land and its people, which he recorded in photo-
graphs, notes, and sketches. Tissot painted his many fig-
ures in costumes he believed to be historically authentic,
carrying out his series with great archaeological correct-
ness. This painting, done in a watercolor technique called
gouache, is in the Collection of the Brooklyn Museum.
