Msgr. Chester Michael - Thought of the Day

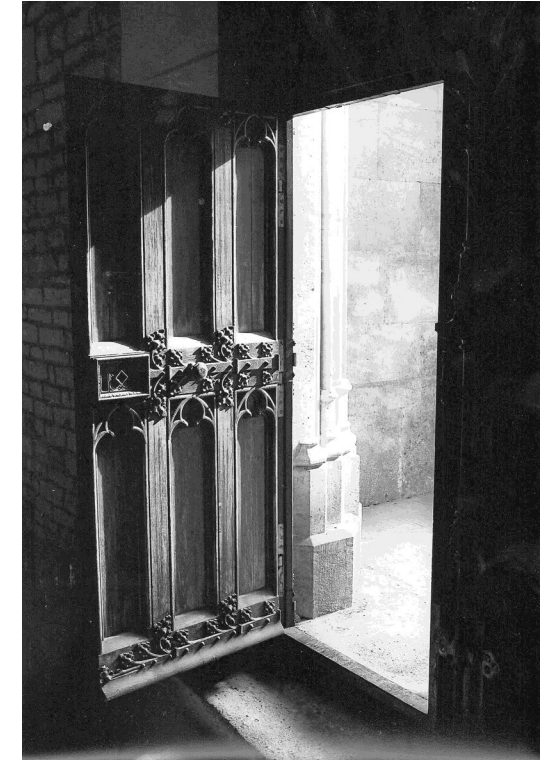

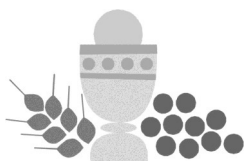
