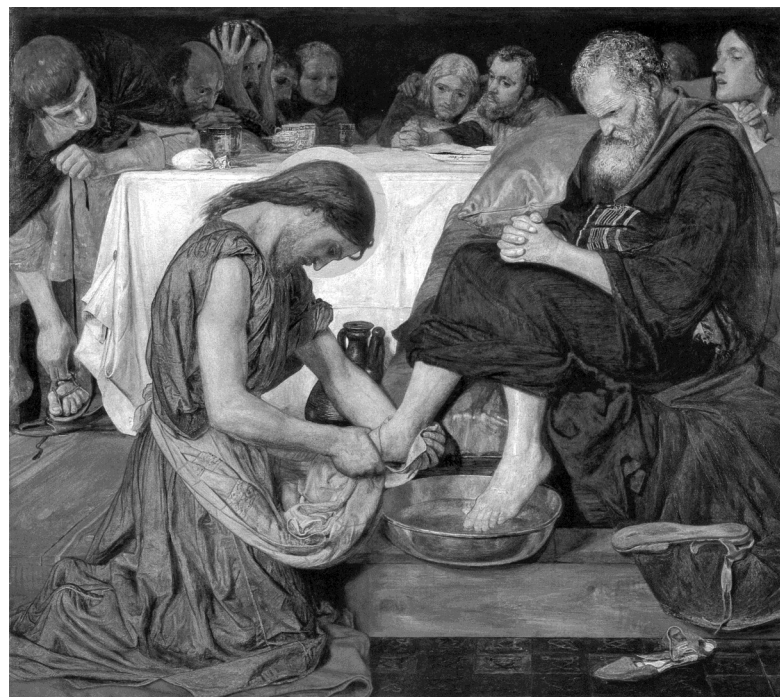

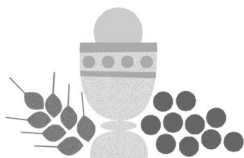

Fundraising Meeting

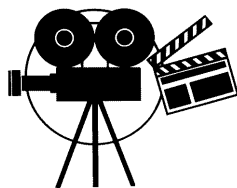
