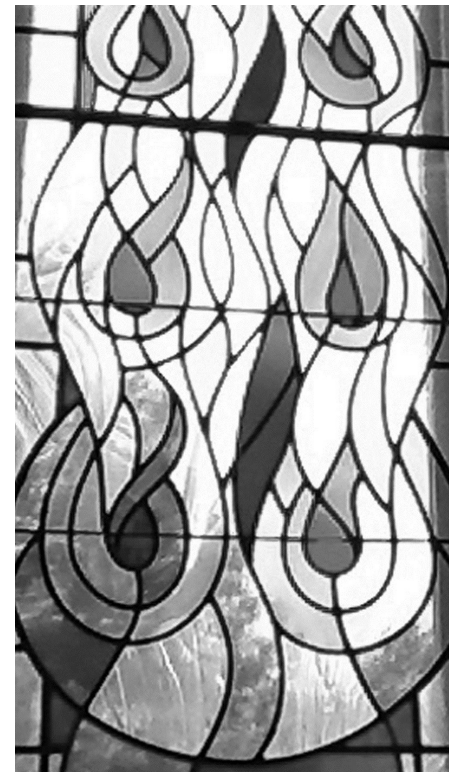
Celebration Women Interdenominational Conference

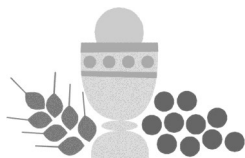

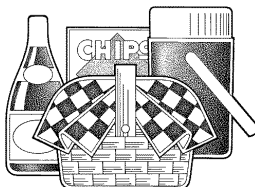
Fr. Jim on Vacation
