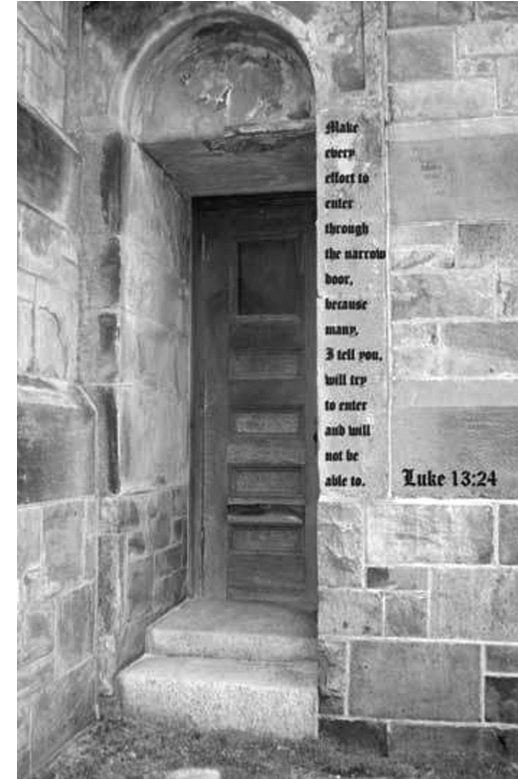
Celebration Women Interdenominational Conference

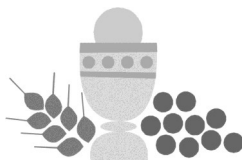
