Father asked me to send this venerable prayer and to remind everyone that we are living in the Age of the Holy Spirit:

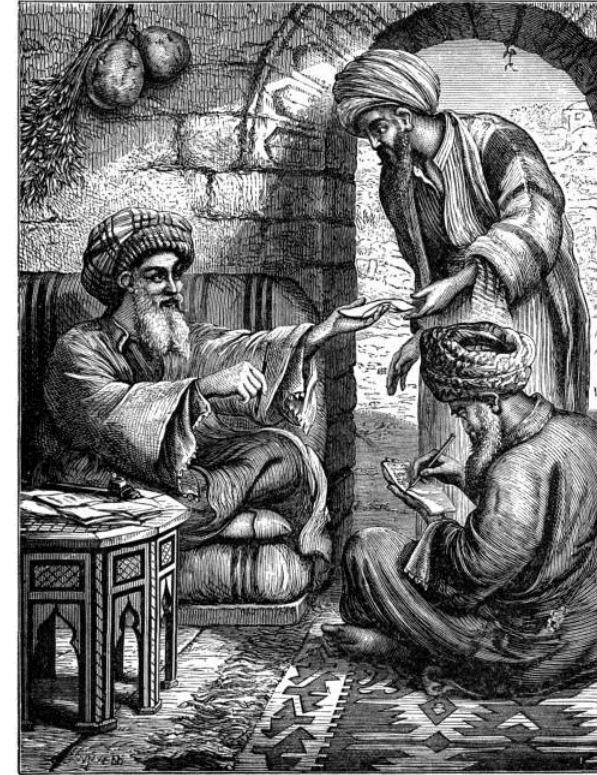
