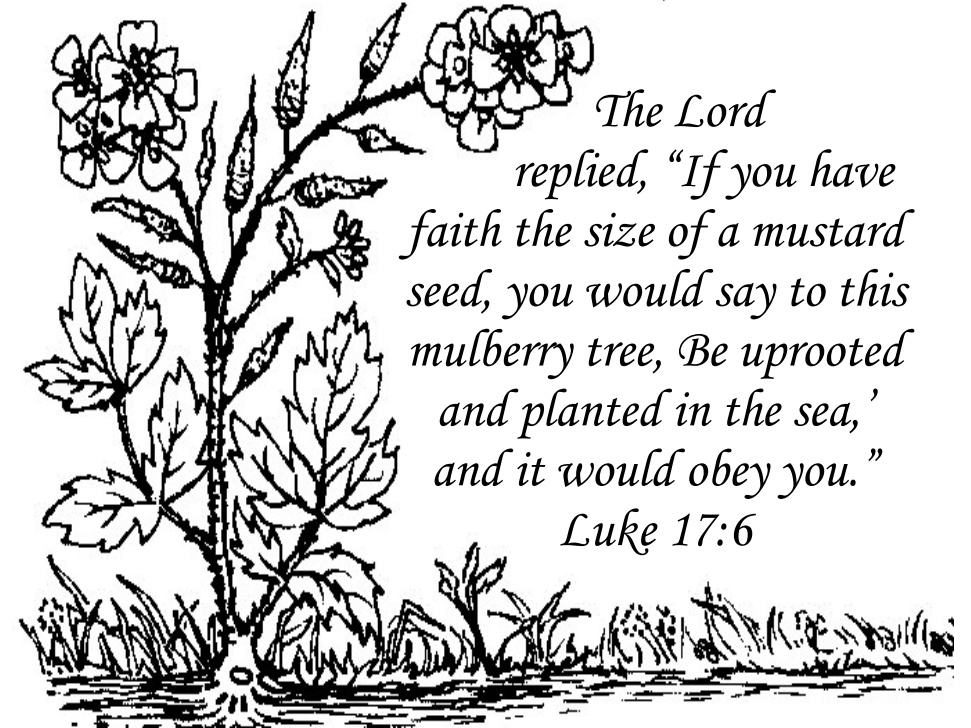
Here is today's message from Father Chet. An oldie, but a goodie:

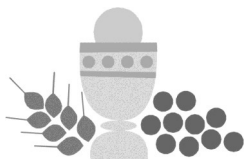
