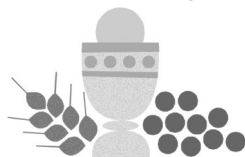

Diocesan Appeal Update

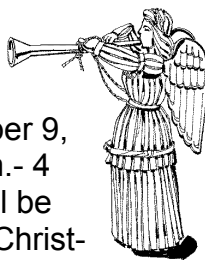
