Angel Tree

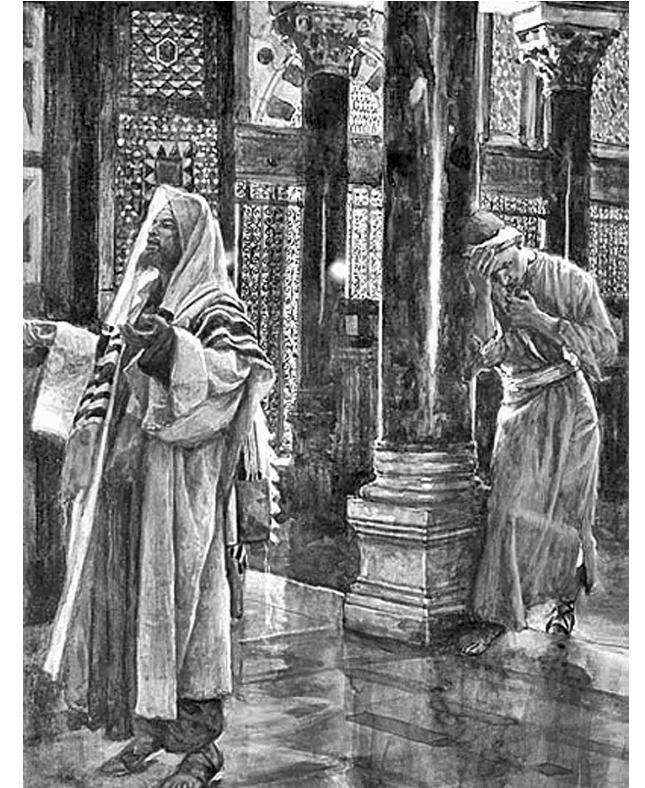

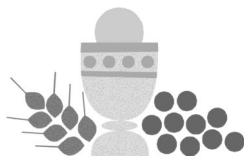

Speaker: Rev. Andrew Ciferni, O. Praem

Fr. Ciferni received his doctorate in liturgical studies from the University of Notre Dame. He has taught at the Catholic University of America and the Washington Theological Union, where he was also academic dean. At Daylesford Abbey, he has served as Rector of the Abbey Church and Director of Mission Advancement. He was a founding member of the North American Academy of Liturgy, and a co-convenor of the study group on art & environment. He is also the founding member and first convenor of the Catholic Academy of Liturgy. Fr. Ciferni has served as an advisor to the U.S. Bishops' Committee on Liturgy, as a member of the international Norbertine Liturgy Commission, and currently is the chair of the international Norbertine Commission on Canonical Life and Spirit of the Order. He has taught a wide range of courses, including the Church Year, Liturgy and Pastoral Care, Environment and Art, and Ritual Music. He also has served as a liturgical consultant on numerous Catholic church designs, including Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Newport News, and St. Stephen Martyr in Chesapeake.
