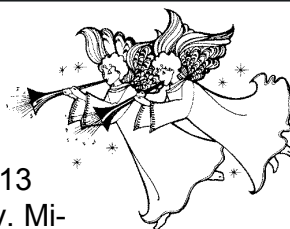

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be offered at mass on Sunday, December 16.

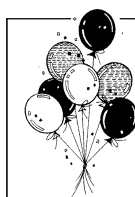
Christmas Decorating
