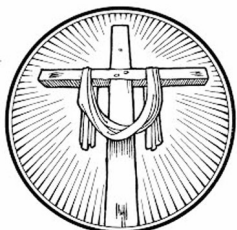

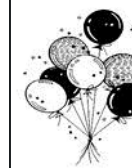


**Divine Mercy**
