13th Annual Hurley Mission Work Week

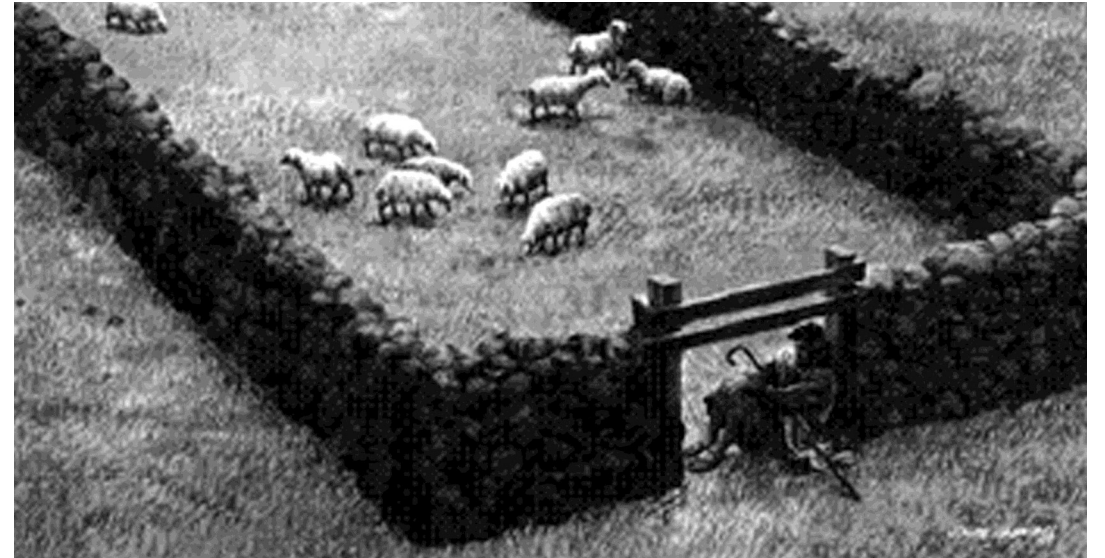

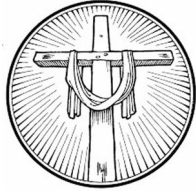

On June 21, from 5-7 p.m., we will have a dinner and entertainment at the

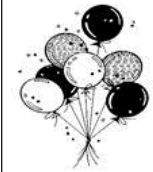

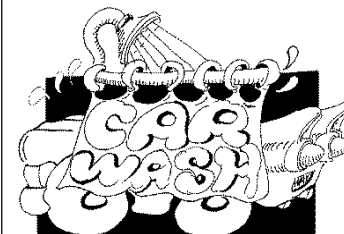
