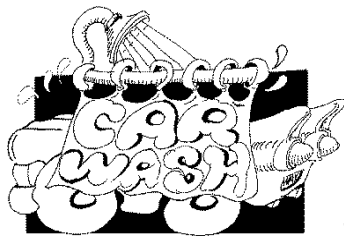

**Car Cleanup Supports a Good Cause**



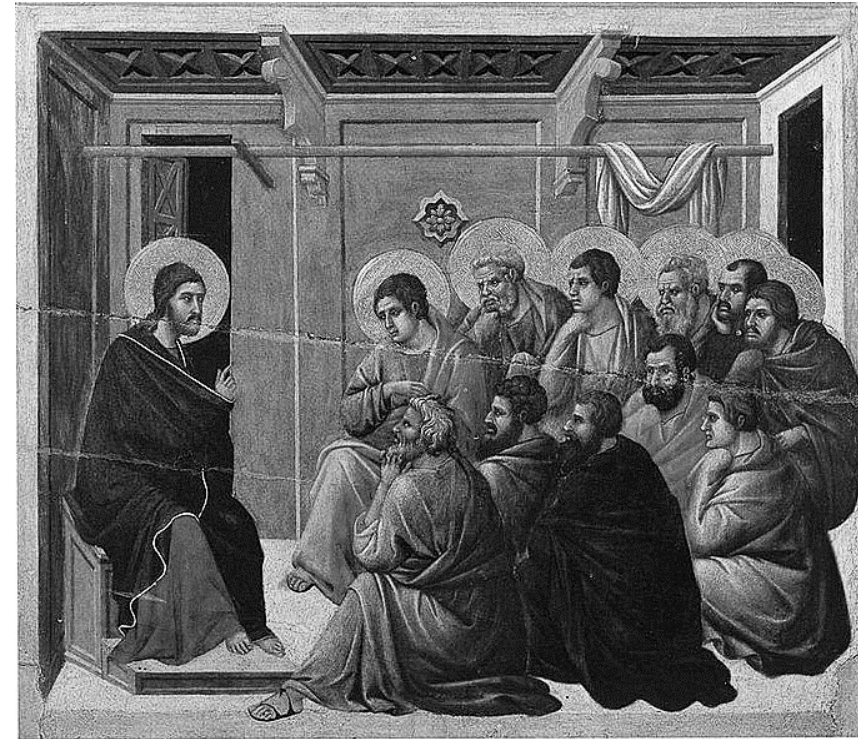

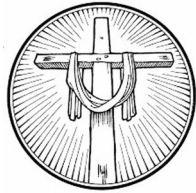

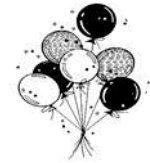
**Fundraiser**
