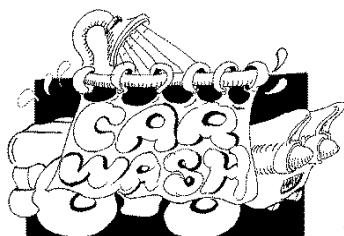

**Car Cleanup Supports a Good Cause**



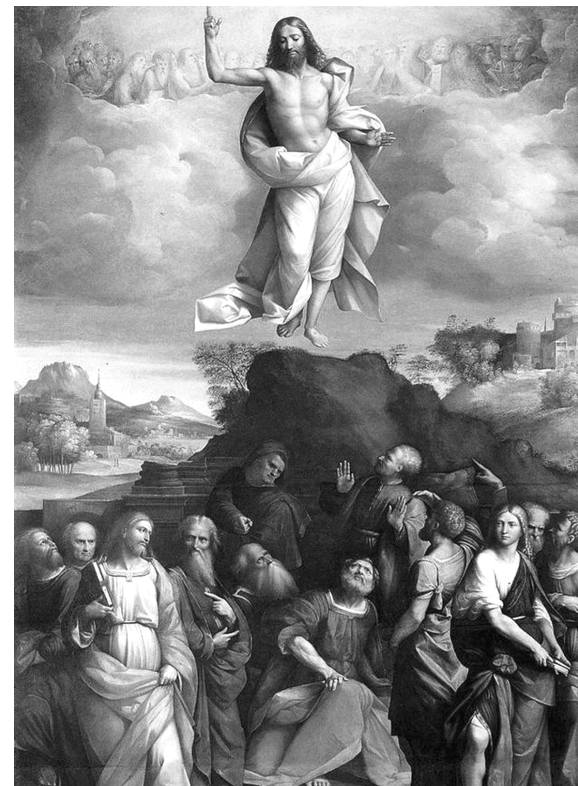

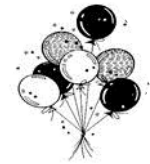
**Guidance on Buildings**

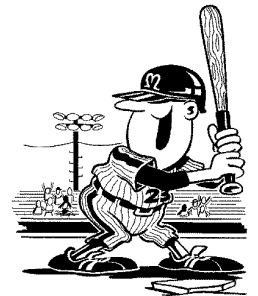
