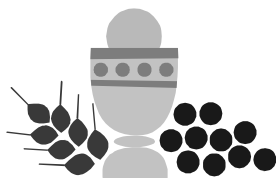

On the Cover

On today's Bulletin cover is a detail from the painting, *The Sower* done in 1850 by French artist Jean Francois Millet. Millet moved to Barbizon after the Cholera epidemic that followed the 1848 revolution in Paris. Barbizon was a popular retreat for landscape painters at the time. It had both wild forests and agricultural lands and yet was close enough to Paris to enable artists to visit the color merchants, dealers, and exhibitions held in the city. Millet's powerful and often large scale treatment of subjects like *The Sower*, was naturally seen as radical in an era when political rights were being demanded by agricultural workers.
