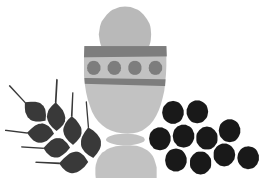

Mark your calendars now for a Lenten Retreat March 13-March 17 at Holy Cross with Brother Loughlan Sofield. Details will be forth coming.

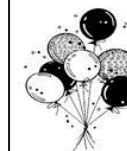
