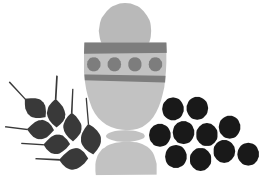

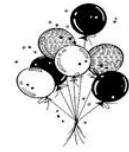
Catechist Retreat
