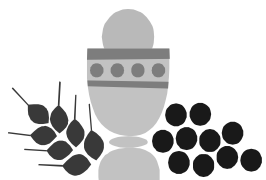

Determining Living Our Mission Case

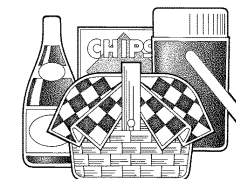
