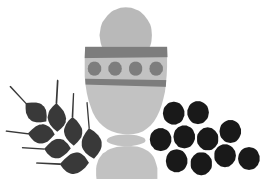

We will remember all of our deceased on Sunday, November 2 at our regular 8:30 a.m. mass. Part of the liturgy will be celebrated in the cemetery.

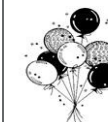
Thanksgiving Giving
