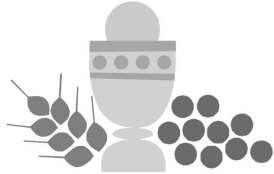

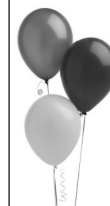


**Sesquicentennial Guest Speaker**
