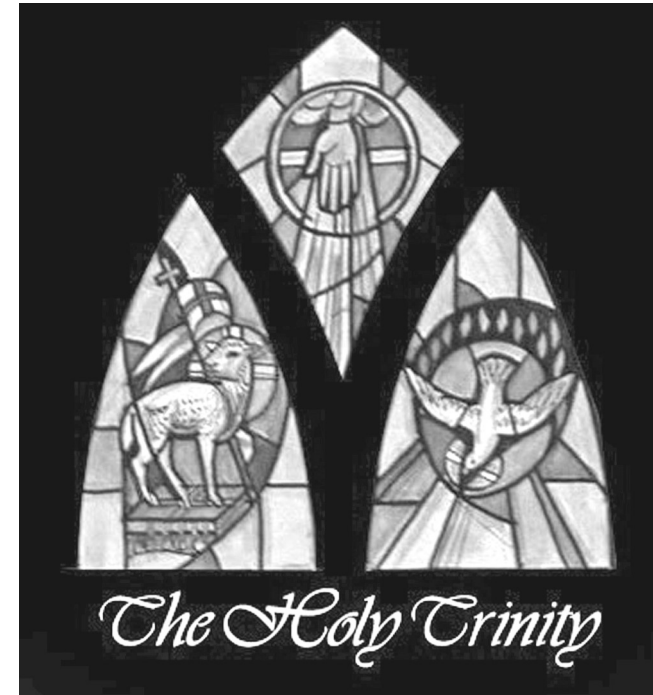

Patsy Mosebrook and Donald Notestein have announced their engagement. They invite the parish to their wedding on June 13 at 12 noon at Our Lady of Peace.

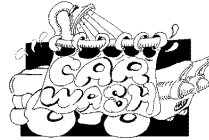
Volunteer Crew Schedules Available
