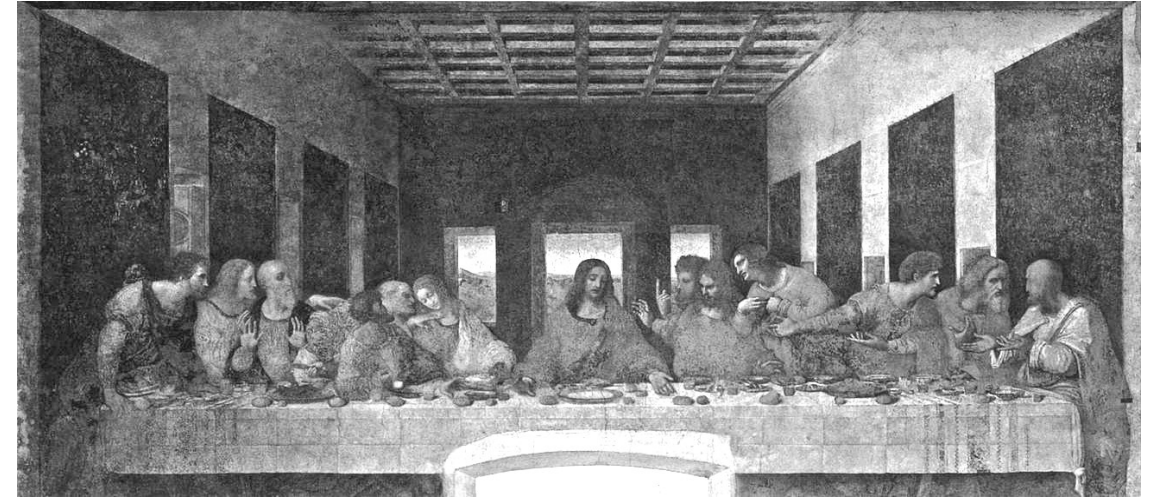

**Wedding Bells!**

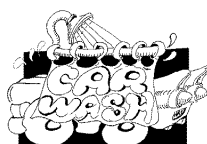
Patsy Mosebrook and
