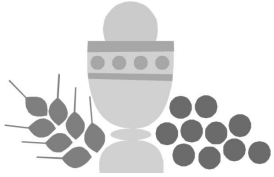

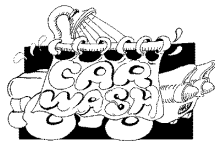
You Met Your Goal!
