Important Cursillo Information

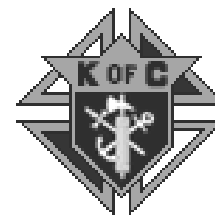

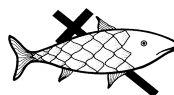
