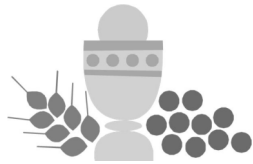

On The Cover

El Greco spent most of his working life in Spain, but the painting on the cover, *Christ Healing the Blind Man*, was completed around 1570, six years before he arrived in Spain. Probably painted in Venice or Rome, It illustrates the Gospel account of Christ healing a blind man by anointing his eyes. The subject was a popular one during the period of the Counter-Reformation. Two other paintings by El Greco with this same theme are in the museums of Dresden and Parma. This one can be found in the Metropolitan Museum of Art.
