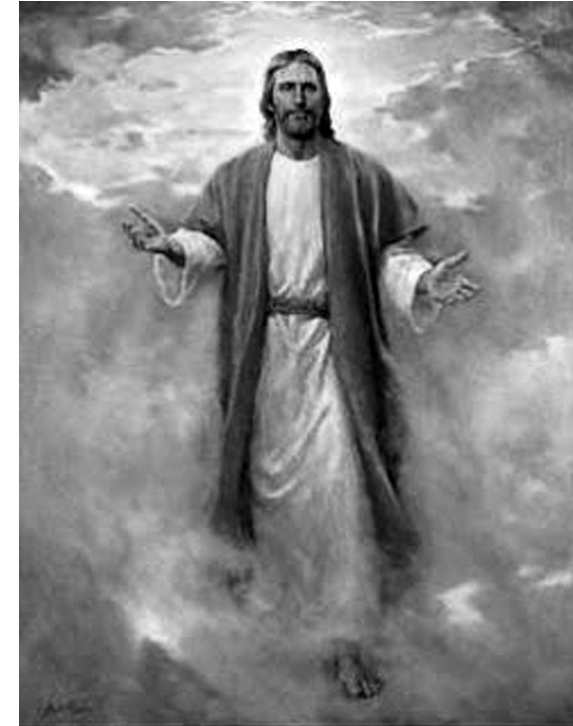

**Feast of the Immaculate Conception**



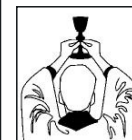
