For Healing After Abortion

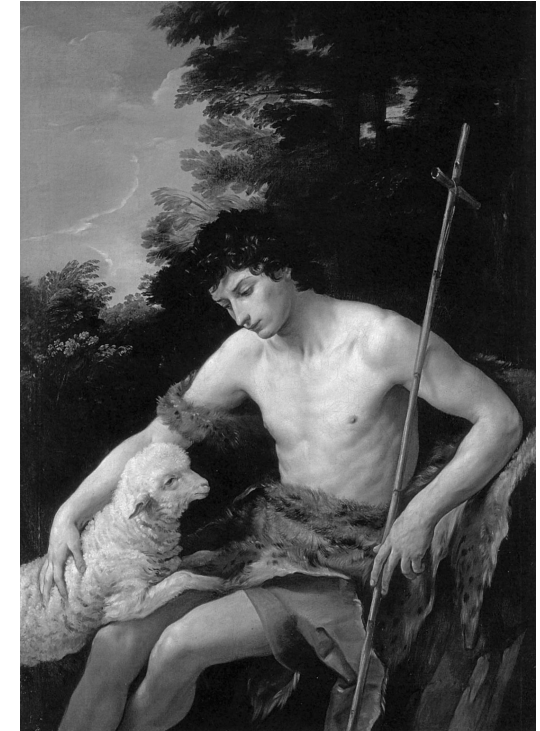
