On the Cover

On today's bulletin cover is a detail from the painting *The Wedding Feast at Cana* by Julius Schnorr von Carolsfeld (1794-1873). This painting represents one of the major works of the Nazarene movement. The artists who embraced this religiously oriented reformation-movement were attempting to revert to and revive the principles and practice of earlier periods. The Nazarenes looked back to medieval ideals and paintings by artists such as Raphael and Dürer.
