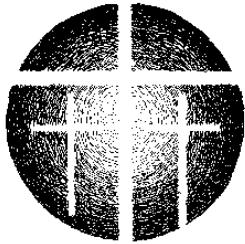

On the Cover

Today's cover is a detail from Italian High Renaissance Master Raphael's painting of the *Transfiguration*. Commissioned by Cardinal Giulio de Medici, the later Pope Clement VII (1523-1534) and conceived as an altarpiece for the Narbonne Cathedral in France, the painting was Raphael's last. He worked on it for four years until his death in 1520. Raphael considered the *Transfiguration* to be his greatest masterpiece. He was so pleased with it that it was prominently displayed behind his deathbed. Currently the painting is on display in the Vatican Museum.
