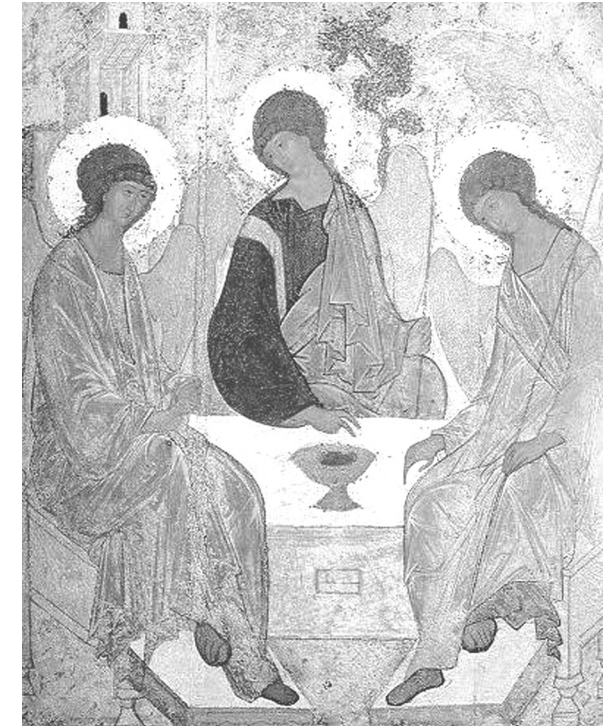

The next meeting of the Cemetery Committee is scheduled for Wednesday, June 15 at 7 p.m.

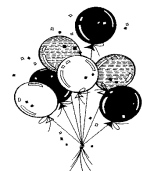

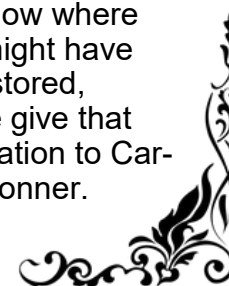

**On the Cover**

On the cover is the Medieval Russian Icon, *The Trinity*, by Andrei Rublev. The subject is the Old Testament story in which Abraham receives three visitors as he camps by the oak of Mamre. Rublev puts the three gold-winged figures around a white table on which a golden chalice-like bowl contains a roasted lamb. The artist has given us many symbols in the icon. For example, The first angel is the first person of the Trinity - God the Father; the second, middle angel is God the Son; the third angel is God the Holy Spirit. All three angels have staves in their hand as a symbol of their divine power. The most important symbol, however, is his composition. The painting is composed in a circle around the table, focusing the viewers' attention on the chalice-bowl at the center—meant to remind us of an altar at Communion.
