**Volunteers Needed**

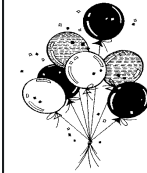
The Good Samaritan Clothing Exchange needs some volunteers to help them out on Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 9 a.m. until noon.

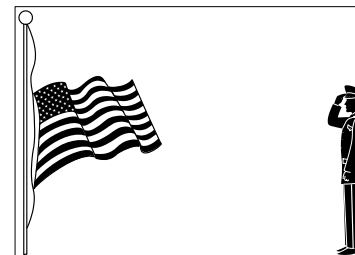

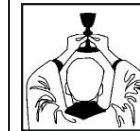

*The Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes reproduced on the cover was painted in 1620 by Giovanni Lanfranco. It was one of the eight Eucharist inspired canvases commissioned for the Blessed Sacrament chapel in the Basilica of Saint Paul Fuori le Mura near Rome. The "upwards-looking" perspective was intentionally created for a work intended to hang high up on the walls.*
