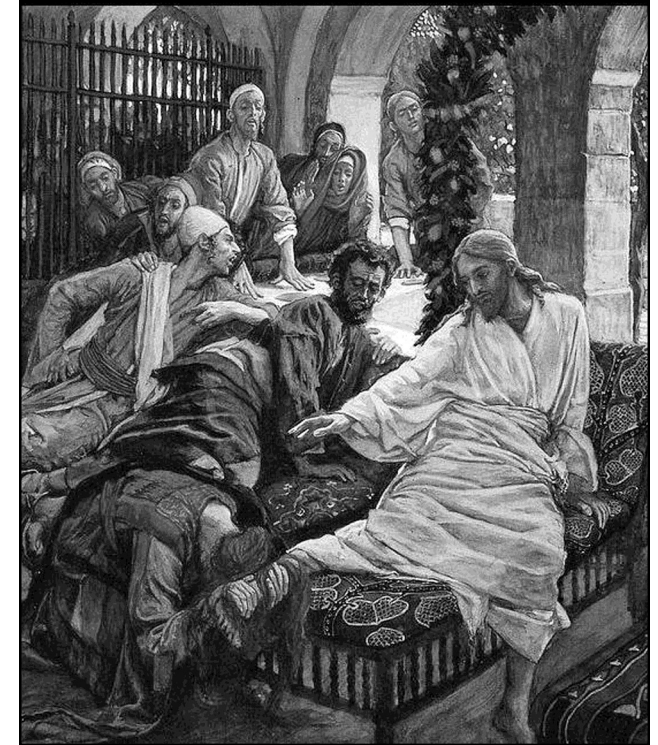

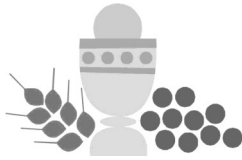

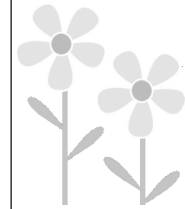
Fr. Dan Bain will be here Sunday, June 26 for mass as Fr. Jim will be away at a conference.

Mary's Garden Party Camp



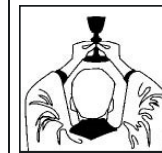
