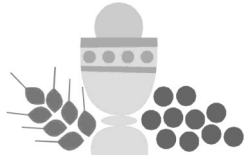

**On the Cover**

*Christ in the House of Martha and Mary* is Vermeer's only known work of a biblical subject and was probably painted around 1654-55. Its bright, intense colors are untypical of Vermeer and the painting was not associated with him until 1901, when his signature was discovered at the lower left on the side of the foot-stool.

St Luke's Gospel tells of Christ's visit to the house of Martha and Mary. Christ praised Mary's willingness to sit and listen to his teachings, unlike Martha who was preoccupied with housekeeping.

Vermeer emphasized the moral of the story by contrasting Christ's pointing hand against the white tablecloth.
