Upcoming Virtus Training

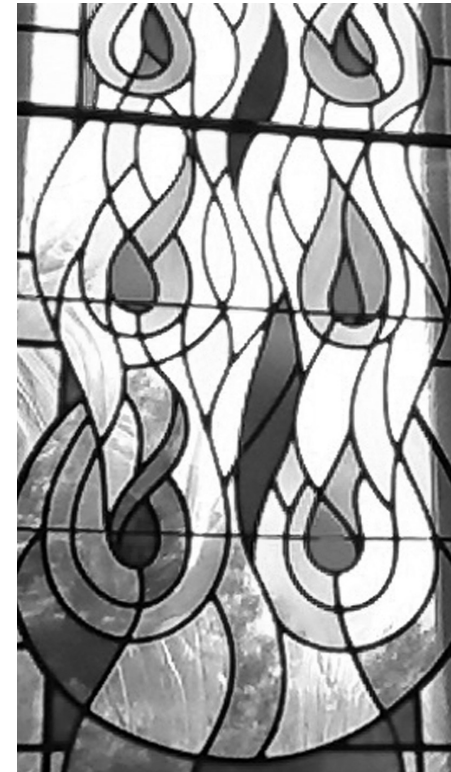
Attention All Volunteers Working with Children

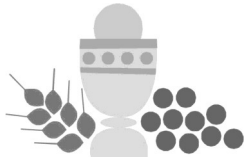

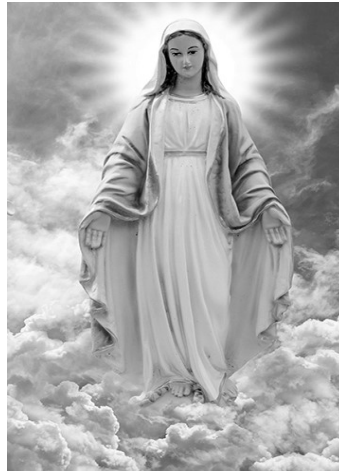

as they search for understanding; and peace and zeal to their hearts.

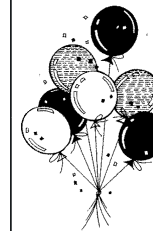
