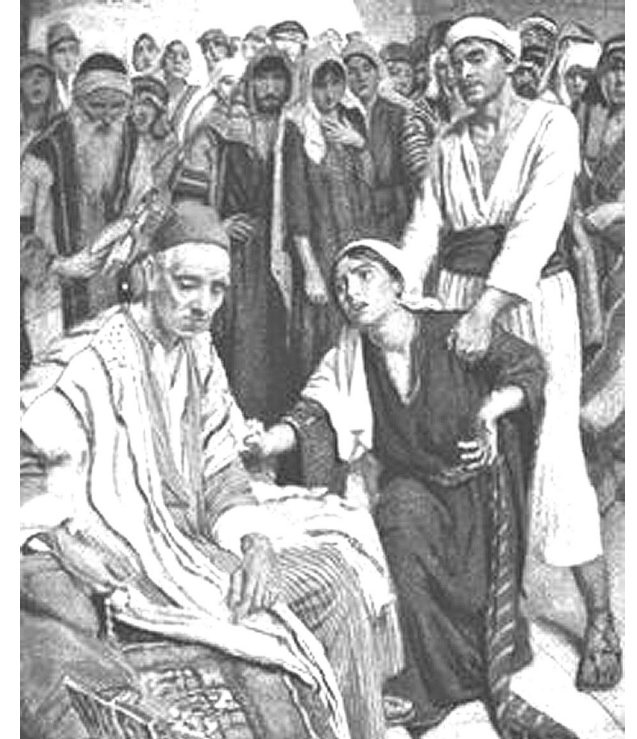

Fr. Jim will be away for a family wedding Friday, October 28 and Saturday, October 29. He will be back for the Sunday masses.


