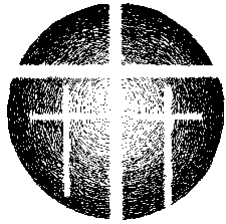

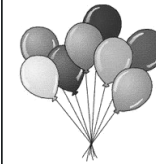

**On the Cover**

On today's cover is the painting, *Jesus and the Sa-  
maritan Woman at the Well* by the Italian Baroque  
artist Giovanni Francesco Barbieri. Barbieri was bet-  
ter known as Guercino which is Italian for squinter.  
The composition, painted between 1640 and 1641,  
reveals Guercino's skill at depicting gestures and ex-  
pressions. The woman is suspicious of this stranger  
who is talking to her. And Christ's pose, with his  
head in profile and his hand upraised, communicates  
his confidence and authority.
