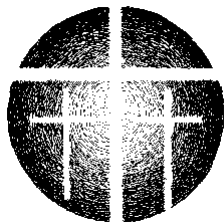

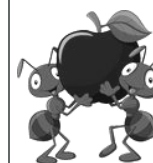
**Adult Formation
