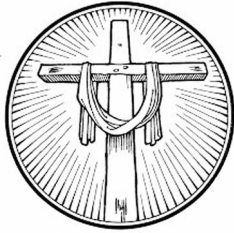

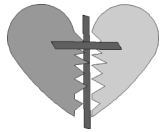

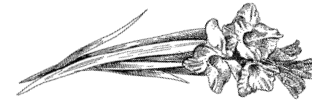
**Calendar Planning**

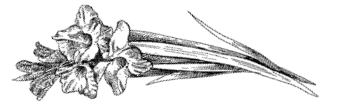

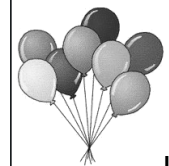
